

First Assembly of God Church Field Rules

See the rules listed below in regards to the use of First Assembly of God Church property. Please abide by these rules at all times. If anyone sees others not abiding, approach the person, or a Board of Director or other designated person to resolve the issue immediately.

1. All athletes, parents, and/or coaches are to park in the current parking lot and walk to field. No vehicle is allowed past the current parking lots at the facility.
2. All athletes, parents, and/or coaches must abide by the speed limit when turning into the church parking lot. We must remember there are other children and/or adults walking the grounds. SAFETY IS KEY A MUST.
3. All athletes, parents, and/or coaches should never peel out, and/or skid in the parking lot including gravel. SAFETY IS A MUST.
4. At the end of every practice, scrimmage, etc., all athletes, parents, and/or coaches are responsible for emptying and/or removing all trash from every trash can regardless of the amount of trash.
5. At the end of every practice, scrimmage, etc., all athletes, parents, and/or coaches are responsible for picking up and discarding any trash left on the field and/or parking lot.
6. AHSA will provide, at a designated place, a portable Latrine.
7. Parents, athletes, and/or children are to stay in designated areas at practices, scrimmages, etc. In order to limit any potential liability risks: no one but athletes and coaches are allowed on field, no excessive rough housing by children, no climbing/playing on bleachers or other structures surrounding field.
8. A Board of Director and/or designated Parent will be in charge at all times at practices, scrimmages, etc. to enforce rules. At the end of each practice, scrimmage, etc., the designated Board Member and/or Parent will be responsible for signing and dating the checklist.
9. AHSA may use designated water distribution point to fill tanks for practices, scrimmages on an as needed basis. Please bring your own water to field if possible.
10. At the end of every practice, scrimmage, etc., all athletes, parents, and/or coaches are responsible for pushing the "football" dummies back against the tree line.
11. Practices are typically from 5-8pm with some players arriving as early as 4:30pm. If board member, or designated parent is available, the athletes may warm up on practice field prior to 5pm. Otherwise, they are not to leave their cars until a designated coach or parent is available. All players must clean and vacate facilities in a reasonable amount of time post practice.
12. Code of Conduct for our players will be strictly enforced. Please uphold our Christian principles in regards to appropriate dress, communication, conduct, etc.
13. AHSA is responsible for assisting the Church with cutting all grass (not just the designated field area). AHSA is responsible for filling up the gas can for lawnmower after each usage. Please remember the Church has been so gracious in allowing AHSA to utilize their property, therefore we need to show our gratitude.

Please remember to show respect to all involved as well as the property which we are so thankful to share. Please use common sense for any issues not directly discussed above. Please notify a board member ASAP if any issues arise so that we may communicate this with the church in a reasonable amount of time.
